Baggage Policy and Web Check-In

According to Swiss Air's luggage allowance rules, a person traveling by SWISS Economy may check-in a maximum of one bag weighing 23 kgs.

SWISS Business class travelers can check two bags, each weighing no more than 32 kgs, for a total weight of no more than 64 kgs.

SWISS First-class travelers can check 3 bags, each weighing no more than 32 kg, for a total weight of less than 96 kg.

You may skip long lines at the airport using **Swiss Air's online check-in service**. Starting 23 hours before departure, you can check in. You can also select your preferred seat and print your boarding card.

You may book your [Swiss Air Flight](#) for a single or return trip in business, Economy, or first-class with Skytripaway.com. You may easily make a reservation by providing your debit or credit card information.

Services and amenities

If you're going with a group, the advance seat reservation function allows you to book seats with extra legroom, window seats, and seats alongside your travel companions. You can reserve a seat in your favorite zone with extra legroom in the Swiss Economy. If you're flying Swiss Business, book a privacy seat. All of this is possible both during and after the flight booking process.

By booking a Light fare in the Swiss Economy that includes hand baggage, you can take advantage of the airlines' additional baggage allowance. You can now book the first piece of luggage at a reduced rate and purchase the second if necessary. If your flight is already booked, you can still book additional baggage up to 2 hours before your scheduled departure time.
